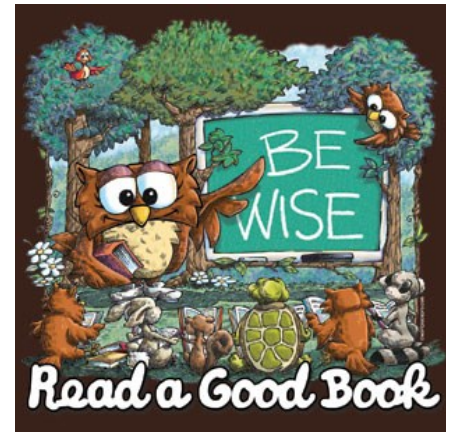

Students can begin turning in prize tickets and payments on September 26th to be eligible for prizes. Pledges must be turned in no later than October 17th to count for prizes. Pledges turned in on or after Tuesday, October 17th, will be gladly accepted, but *will not be counted toward prizes*.

### **Important Dates**

Kick Off: on Tuesday, September 20th - Start contacting Sponsors and finding good books!  
Reading Competition: September 26th through October 10th  
Coupons Turn In Dates: September 27th through October 17th  
Final Pledge Sheet & Reading Record Turn In Date: October 17th

### **Reading Units**

Reading dates start Monday, September 26th; reading units count until Monday, October 10th. For a unit to count, a parent, teacher or other adult must sign off on the units. Students in K3 through 2nd grade may count time that someone reads to them.

### **Reading units:**

Grades K3—K5: 1 unit is 10 minutes of reading

Grades 1—3: 1 unit is 20 minutes of reading

Grades 4—6: 1 unit is 30 minutes of reading

Adult reading to child grades K3 through 2nd: 1 unit is 20 minutes of reading.
