Junior High

Please bring general supplies and homeroom supplies to orientation on August 19.

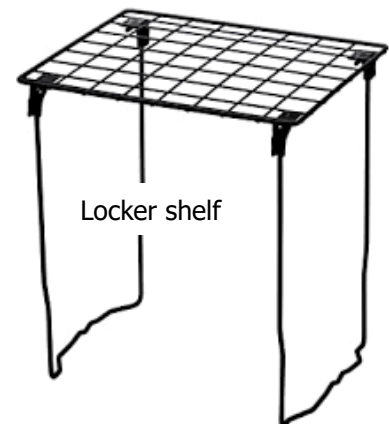
Textbook note: All rented (non-consumable) textbooks must be covered at all times. Brown grocery bag covers with cardboard reinforcement work perfectly. All rental and consumable books must have the student's name written in ink in the proper place inside the book. Students are not permitted to write in rental textbooks. If there is writing inside rental textbooks or the books show wear beyond normal use (covers and binding should remain intact, interior pages should not be bent or torn), the student's account will be charged a fee up to the full replacement cost for the textbook. All rental textbooks are expected to remain in good repair for at least three years.

General Supplies

- Bible – Authorized King James Version
- Locker dividers (required to keep lockers neat)
- Wide-ruled looseleaf notebook paper. No spiral-bound notebooks.
- Pens (at least 4, blue or black ink) and pencils
- **NO spiral notebooks.**

Homeroom Supplies – Turn in to your homeroom teacher on Orientation Night.

- Copy paper – 2 reams (500 sheets each)
- Disinfectant wipes or hand sanitizer (8-ounce bottle) – Boys
- Dry erase markers and eraser – Boys

- Protractor with ruler-English and Metric
- Compass

8th Grade

- Graph paper
