

<u>CLASS SUPPLY LIST – K3</u> 2024-2025

Bring all supplies to your classroom at Orientation on August 19.

- Zippered soft pencil pouch, 7 inches by 10 inches
- Crayons (<u>8 basic colors</u>), fat, triangular shape 2 boxes
- Washable markers 1 box
- Coloring book 1 (no television shows, movies, video games, or music groups)
- Colored pencils 1 package
- Safety scissors 1 pair of child-sized
- Solid glue stick 1 large
- Watercolor paint set (8 colors)
- No-spill water bottle/drink cup. Please label with child's name.
- Copy paper 2 reams (500 sheets each)
- Cardstock paper Boys
- Band-aids 1 Girls
- Tissues 2 boxes
- Wipes 2 boxes unscented (not "Pampers")
- Clorox wipes 2 containers
- Hand sanitizer
- Ziploc bags (gallon or snack size)
- Wrapped candy for treat box 1 bag
- Box Tops for Education Download the app and scan your receipts!
- Medium sized backpack
- Optional: Playground sand toys and trucks or Nerf-style ball for the playground

Label all personal items **BOLD** with permanent marker. **Label** your child's outerwear (coats, hats, gloves, etc.) and uniforms.

Optional items we need throughout the year: Wrapped candy, Ziploc-style bags (all sizes), treasure box toys, Lysol, card stock paper.

Bring all items to the classroom on Orientation day.

Please note: Students in K3-12th grade are required to wear uniforms. They can be purchased at Land's End (CCS #900126426) or French Toast (CCS # QS446EC). Girls jumpers do not need a school logo.

Please bring a change of clothing including shoes to keep in the classroom. These must be labeled with your child's name and placed in a <u>large Ziploc bag</u>. (If your child will stay for 3 p.m. or 6 p.m. Patriots Club, he/she will need <u>TWO changes of clothing</u> in <u>separate</u>, <u>labeled</u>, <u>Ziploc bags</u>).
