



CLASS SUPPLY LIST – K4 **2026-2027**

Bring all supplies to your classroom at Orientation.

- Backpack book bag. No wheels, please.
- Plastic school supply box, 6" x 9" (anything larger will not fit in the desk)
- (2 boxes) Crayons
- (3 sets of 8 colors each) Watercolor paint
- (2 sets) Washable markers
- Dry erase board, approximately 9" x 12" with the lines for writing
- (1 box of at least 8 basic colors) Dry erase markers
- Coloring book – 1 (no television shows, movies, video games, or music groups, please)
- Scissors - good quality, child-sized (Fiskars recommended)
- (4 large-sized) glue sticks
- (3 boxes) Tissues
- (2 boxes unscented) Wipes
- (2 reams of 500 sheets) Copy paper
- (2 containers) Disinfectant wipes
- Stickers and small treasure box toys
- Box Tops for Education – Download the app and start scanning your receipts!
- Girls – white cardstock (1) pack
- Boys – colored cardstock (1) pack
- Optional: Playground ball, nerf-type ball, heavy-duty toys for playground

NOTES

Label pencil box, coloring book, and scissors with permanent marker. Bring all items to the classroom on Orientation Day. Optional items we need throughout the year: cough drops, Ziploc-style bags (all sizes), treasure box toys, additional paper, and Lysol.

Please note: Students in K3-12th grade are required to wear uniforms. They can be purchased at Lands End (CCS #900126426) or Metro School Uniforms. Girls' jumpers do not need a school logo.

Label your child's outerwear (coats, hats, gloves, etc.) and uniforms.

Please bring two changes of clothing so we have one to keep in the classroom and one in the lunchroom. These must be labeled with your child's name and placed in a large, Ziploc bag. (If your child will stay for the extended day Patriots Club, he/she will need two changes of clothing in separate, labeled, Ziploc bags).
