

Calvary Christian School: Christian College Scholarship for Seniors

Award Amount: \$2,500

Purpose: The Calvary Christian School Christian College Scholarship for Seniors is established to encourage and support graduating seniors who are continuing their education at a Christian college. This scholarship reflects our commitment to fostering lifelong discipleship, academic excellence, and spiritual growth among our students.

Eligibility Requirements: To be considered for the scholarship, applicants must:

- Be a graduating senior at Calvary Christian School.
- Apply to, be accepted to, and enroll at one of the following Christian colleges:
 - Bob Jones University, South Carolina
 - Anderson University, South Carolina
 - Columbia International University, South Carolina
 - Charleston Southern University, South Carolina
 - Pensacola Christian College, Florida
 - Faith Baptist Bible College, Iowa
 - Maranatha Baptist University, Wisconsin
 - Liberty University, Virginia
 - Cedarville University, Ohio
 - North Greenville University, South Carolina
- Demonstrate acceptance and enrollment into one of the Christian colleges listed above for the year immediately following graduation from CCS (proof of acceptance required).

Application Requirements: Applicants must submit:

- Completed Scholarship Application Form (to be provided by the school).
- Proof of acceptance into one of the approved Christian colleges.
- Essay (700–1,000 words): Respond to the following prompt: “Why is it important for your spiritual life to attend a Christian college?”
- Recommendation letter from a current/recent teacher or pastor.

Scholarship Use: The scholarship funds (disbursed directly to the college) may be applied toward any college-related expenses, including:

- Tuition
- Room and board
- Program fees
- Textbooks
- Other academic or living costs associated with college enrollment that can be paid for through the student’s college account

Selection Process: A scholarship committee appointed by Calvary Christian School administration will review all applications. Scholarship committee must include at least one teacher who currently teaches the senior class in any subject. Essays will be evaluated on depth of thought, clarity, organization, and personal reflection on the spiritual significance of attending a Christian college. The scholarship will be awarded to the applicant(s) who best demonstrates academic commitment, spiritual maturity, and a clear vision for how attending a Christian college will impact their walk with Christ. All awards are subject to final approval by the scholarship benefactor.
