

CLASS SUPPLY LIST – GRADE 3

Bring all supplies to your homeroom on Orientation afternoon.

Label **BOLD** supply items with your child's name in permanent marker. Please have colored pencils, glue, and scissors unwrapped and in your child's school box for Orientation. Bookbags with wheels are NOT allowed.

- **Pencil box**—No larger than 7 inches by 12 inches <u>and</u> no taller than 4 inches. This is for colored pencils, crayons, glue sticks, scissors, and erasers. *Please do not bring any pencil boxes larger than the above or anything fancy as it will not fit inside their desks*.
- o 1 round pencil case or a round toothbrush holder (for easy access to pencils inside desks).
- o Crayola Twistables Colored Pencils and/or Crayola Twistables Crayons-one 12- or 24-pack
- o Highlighter/s
- o Small pack of red pens
- o Safety scissors—1 pair
- o Ruler (clear)—1 that can measure inches and centimeters
- o 1—3-prong folder with pockets
- o 2—1-inch three-ring binders (two different colors, exactly 1-inch, no trapper keepers)
- o 2 composition books—wide ruled—different colors
- o Bible—Authorized King James Version only—available in the office for \$5.00
- 1—3- or 6-pack of glue sticks
- Ticonderoga #2 pencils—3 packs of 12 or more (*please* have them sharpened)
- Erasers—4 block or chunk style AND 2 packs of endcap erasers (white hi-polymer are best)
- o Wide-ruled loose-leaf notebook paper—2 packs
- 1 pack of construction paper (sorted by color if possible)
- Copy paper—2 reams (500 sheets)
- Dry erase markers—2 or 3 (at least), large size in any color
- Cough drops—1-2 bags
- o Tissues—1-2 boxes—<u>Girls Only</u>
- o Clorox or Lysol Wipes (1 container)—Boys Only
- o Optional: Playground ball, basketball, soccer ball, or a volleyball for the playground
- Optional items we need throughout the year (you may donate these anytime of the year): Skittles, M&Ms, Jolly Ranchers, Hershey Kisses, Smarties (or other treat candies), treasure box toys, additional reams of copy paper, dry erase markers

Notes:

Please, no markers of any kind and no individual pencil sharpeners.

Label your child's outerwear (coats, hats, gloves, etc.) and uniforms.

ALL non-consumable books MUST be covered at the beginning of the year to last duration of the year.
