



CLASS SUPPLY LIST – K4

Bring all supplies to your classroom at Orientation on August 21.

- Backpack book bag. No wheels, please.
- Plastic school supply box 6” x 9” (anything larger will not fit in the desk)
- Clipboard, approximately 9” x 12”
- Crayons – 2 boxes
- Watercolor paint – 2 sets of 8 colors each
- Washable Markers – 2 sets
- Dry erase board, approximately 9” x 12” with the lines for writing
- Dry erase markers – 1 box (at least 8 basic colors)
- Coloring book – 1 (no television shows, movies, video games, or music groups, please)
- Scissors – 1 pair of good quality, child-sized (Fiskars recommended)
- Glue – 4 large sized solid glue sticks
- “Play-Doh” – 3 cans (“Play-Doh” brand only; other brands stain and stick to the carpet)
- Tissues – 3 boxes
- Wipes – 2 boxes unscented
- Copy paper – 2 reams of 500 sheets
- Disinfectant wipes – 2 containers
- Mr. Clean magic eraser
- Girls – white cardstock (1) pack
- Boys – construction paper (1) pack
- Stickers and small treasure box toys
- Optional: Playground ball, nerf-type ball, heavy duty toys for playground
- Box Tops for Education – Download the app and start scanning your receipts!

NOTES

Label pencil box, coloring book and scissors with permanent marker. Bring all items to the classroom on Orientation Day. Optional items we need throughout the year: cough drops, Skittles, wrapped candy, Ziploc-style bags (all sizes), treasure box toys, additional paper and Lysol.

Label your child’s outerwear (coats, hats, gloves, etc.) and uniforms.

Please bring two changes of clothing so we have one to keep in the classroom and one in the lunchroom. These must be labeled with your child’s name and placed in a large, Ziploc bag. (If your child will stay for 3 p.m. or 6 p.m. Patriots Club, he/she will need THREE changes of clothing in separate, labeled, Ziploc bags).
