



Dear Parents and Students,

We are excited about our junior high spiritual emphasis trip to *The Anchorage*! This will be three days of great fun as well as great Bible teaching. The purpose of this trip is to help unify the student body around the spiritual purposes and goals for this year.

To make this trip the best that it can be, the following guidelines will be observed.

Cost: \$115.00 - Due Monday, September 16th.

Departure Time: 8:00 am. Wednesday, October 2nd

** The bus will be pulling away from CCS at 8:30 am! We will load the bus at 8:15. **PLEASE BE ON TIME!**

Each student **MUST** bring:

A Bible

Bedding (twin bed), pillows, towels, toiletries

Clothes (you may get wet) The Dress Code is attached to this letter.

Minimum of two (2) pair of tennis shoes.

Dress for the bus trip:

The dress code for the trip should follow *The Anchorage* dress code. Anyone wearing questionable dress will be asked to change before we leave. Please make sure that all shorts are knee length.

Prohibited items: (This list comes from *The Anchorage*. Students will NOT be allowed to leave anything on the bus and therefore should NOT bring any of these items.) Cell phones, CD's, iPods, MP3 players (any electronic device used for games/music/movies), playing cards, magazines, tobacco products, and computers.

Special Note: Students are not allowed to use phones except in emergencies. In the event of an emergency, you may phone *The Anchorage* office at (910) 646-4111, day or night.

You may also call our sponsors. Sponsors will be determined closer to the trip date. We will give you their cell phone numbers at that time.

Return Time: The bus will leave *The Anchorage* between 1:00pm and 1:30pm, Friday, October 4th.

The bus will return to CCS, Friday, between 2:30 and 3:00 pm. You may pick your child up at that time.

Meals – Meals will be provided at the camp. Students will need to bring money for any snacks they may want to purchase.

GENERAL INFORMATION

What to Bring: Each camper should bring bedding for a single bed, pillow, towels, toiletries and other personal items, Bible, flashlight and spending money**. Optional items include roller-skates or indoor blades, fishing poles, cameras, and a notebook.

**We have a snack shop and a gift shop/book store available. Spending money is suggested for each camper if they wish to purchase snacks or souvenirs during the week.

Do NOT Bring: Radio, CD or Mp3 players, iPods, video games, playing cards, magazines, tobacco products, cell phones or computers.

Dress: BOYS— For daily activities tank tops are not permitted and shorts must be approximately knee length; collared shirts and long pants are required for evening services.
