***Tuition Credit Referral Program***

Refer your friends and family to Calvary! Referring families receive a \$500 tuition credit for each family that enrolls, and each referred family receives a \$100 tuition credit.

### *Financial Policies*

1. No monthly statements will be mailed.
2. All fees other than tuition are non-refundable and non-transferable. Tuition is non-refundable if the student has been to school any day during the month, or if the student withdraws without proper notification. Exception may be made if the account has been paid in full for the school year. Monthly payments have been calculated based upon an annual rate and are due in full regardless of the number of school days in any given month.
3. Unpaid balances cannot be carried over from one month to the next. Parents who do not pay by the 25<sup>th</sup> of the month will be notified that their children may not attend classes on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the new month.
4. Students whose accounts are not current by the end of each semester will not be allowed to take their final exams for that semester. Students who do not take final exams will receive no credit for that semester's work. There will be a financial hold on report cards, transcripts, and other school records if payment is not current at the end of each month.
5. Any special financial arrangements must be requested in writing and approved by the administration.
